School PayPoint Card for payment for school lunches

Many schools will issue a PayPoint Payment Card for cashless dinner money payments. These PayPoint payments for schools are automatically credited to your child's dinner money account.

PayPoint payments for school trips with barcode letters

PayPoint payments for school trips and other school activities help create completely cashless schools. School can send you letters with barcodes to collect cashless payments for any school items.

Please only use each barcode letter for the payment detailed on the letter, as each barcode is linked to a different school payment item.
